Yesterday 25 athletes competed for one of 8 places in today's finals. There were surprises in those qualifiers and some of the favourite athletes did not qualify, while some outsiders managed to reach the finals. Today the athletes were in good shape, over-motivated and galvanised by the audience who came to applaud and encourage them. The heat did not scare them, as proof the

first 6 athletes in the list did not exceed 11 seconds during their first run, a real feat! The three winners who were able to reach the podium were in order: Alberto Gomez, who came in first place with a run of 10.24 seconds, Christian Harmat, in second place with a run of 10.65 seconds and Oleksandr Titarenko who came third with a run of 10.77 seconds.

The athletes were at their best today and produced some outstanding runs! Encouraged by the crowd, the level was exceptionally high. It was finally the Russian athlete Aleksandra Shevchenko who won and took home the gold medal, with a score of 24.5. Second place was Adela Merkova of the Czech Republic, who won the silver medal with a similar score of 24.5 (the two athletes were separated according to their marks during the qualifications).

The Japanese athlete Hikari Izumi was third place on the podium with a score of 23, following an exceptional run in which she injured her shin. We still hope to see her tomorrow at the Parkour Speed Run finals, as she qualified in first place this morning.
