Since 1997, FISE has established Montpellier as the world capital of urban sports. EDITORIALS

"In Occitanie, as everywhere in France, the practice of urban sports continues its remarkable growth, now bringing together nearly 2.5 million participants nationwide. Their gradual inclusion in the Olympic program, from BMX Freestyle and skateboarding in Tokyo, to Breaking and 3x3 basketball at the Paris Games, marked a decisive milestone by giving them the recognition and visibility they fully deserve. This year, particular attention will be given to Parkour with the first stage of the World Gymnastics World Cup, in a discipline that is a candidate for the Olympic program.

That is why I am particularly proud that the Occitanie Region is once again supporting FISE for this 2026 edition. It has become one of the most followed sporting events in France, alongside the biggest international competitions. Each year, it brings together hundreds of thousands of spectators and nearly 1,500 riders on the banks of the Lez, at the foot of the Regional Government building in Montpellier. Much more than a competition, FISE is a popular, festive, and intergenerational event that radiates our region far beyond its borders.

In the legacy of the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, we must continue to sustain the sporting momentum they created and encourage lifelong participation in sport for everyone. True to this commitment, the Occitanie Region works daily to support clubs, assist athletes, and host international events that contribute to the attractiveness and dynamism of our territory. FISE is a perfect example of this, confirming Occitanie's recognized expertise in organizing major sporting events.

Committed to making sport accessible to as many people as possible, the Region will once again this year allow high school students to benefit from a reduced fare thanks to the "Carte Jeune Région".

On the eve of this new edition, I wish all enthusiasts, athletes, and organizers an event marked by sharing, freedom, and creativity – values that define the unique spirit of FISE and the pride of Occitanie."

Occitanie, the region of urban sports

Occitanie is the region of urban and extreme sports. With the organization of major events such as FISE (Montpellier), the Mondial du Vent (Leucate), the European Freestyle Ski Cup (Font-Romeu), the Stop One 3x3 Basketball event (Toulouse), Breaking History (Montauban), as well as the establishment of the national BMX Freestyle center in Montpellier, the region enables regular practice of these disciplines.

To support this dynamic, the Region supports:

- The construction of specialized facilities, having backed more than 120 new skatepark/pumptrack projects since 2020, for a total of €3.5 million, including in Espéraza, Laudun-l'Ardoise, Vauvert, Lourdes, Muret, and Vias.
- Clubs that train athletes who shine on the international and Olympic stage, such as Passion BMX in Sérignan with Laury Perez, Anthony Jeanjean, and Istvan Caillet; Attitude in Montpellier and Brave'arts in Perpignan with Louise Aïna Taboulet in skateboarding; and the breaking scene, with support for Break'in School in Colomiers, All Styles in Alès, and Breaking Montpellier.
- Athletes, with more than 25 high-level sportswomen and sportsmen supported by the Region through individualized assistance in these disciplines in 2025.

FISE Montpellier 2026 will host 9 disciplines and more than 70 competitions, once again confirming its role as a benchmark event on the global urban sports calendar.

At the core of the program are 4 official World Cup stops:

UCI BMX Freestyle Park (Men & Women)

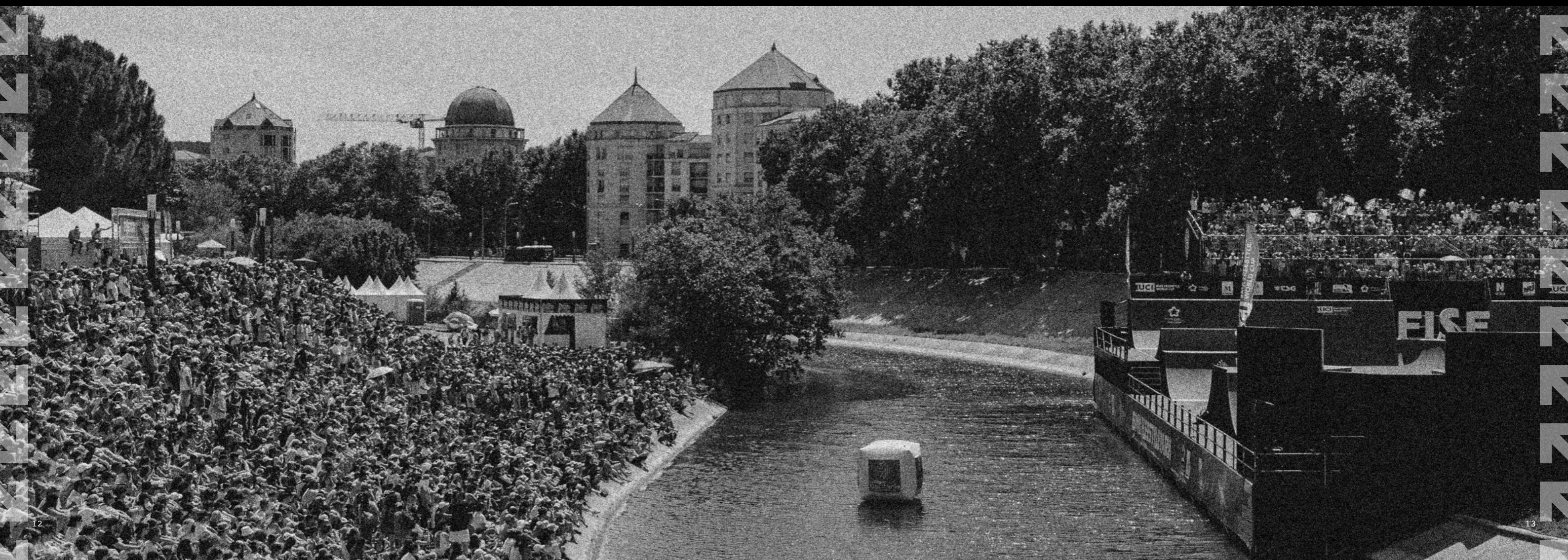
UCI BMX Freestyle Flatland (Men & Women)

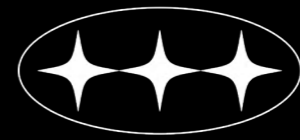
Parkour World Cup - Speed (Men & Women)

The festival's historic disciplines remain a key highlight, brought to life by riders from all over the world and an ever-growing audience. This year, FISE takes a further step forward with two fully dedicated Parkour areas: a Speed track and a Freestyle zone, providing this fast-growing discipline with a setup that matches its international ambitions.

Also making its debut is the **Fusion Park**, a concept designed and developed by Hurricane Parks to reconnect practice with its roots and original spirit, which will be unveiled for the very first time at FISE Montpellier. This marks a major milestone in park design and in the history of action sports events.

All FISE disciplines take place on areas and parks specially designed and built by Hurricane Parks. These structures are adapted both to the demands of high-level athletes and to accessibility for amateur and junior levels.



BMX FREESTYLE PARK PODIUM – FISE MONTPELLIER 2025 – MEN



MARCUS CHRISTOPHER
USA

A professional since the age of 13, Marcus Christopher has established himself as one of the most talented riders in the United States. After a serious crash at the Los Angeles X Games that kept him away from the parks for over six weeks, he made a notable return to the international scene in 2023. Since then, Marcus has confirmed his rise among the world elite. He finished 4th at the Paris Olympic Games and won FISE Montpellier, ranking 5th in the 2025 UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup.



ANTHONY JEANJEAN
FRANCE

A “made in FISE Montpellier” rider, he discovered BMX at age 10 before quickly excelling in national and international competitions. A three-time European champion and winner of the 2024 UCI BMX Freestyle World Cup, his performances helped France secure a spot at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. In 2024, he won FISE Montpellier for the first time before earning the bronze medal at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. In 2025, Anthony delivered an exceptional season. Crowned world champion in Riyadh, he went on to win the overall 2025 UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup ranking. With this double achievement, he became the first rider in history to accomplish this feat, confirming his status as a global benchmark.



DYLAN HESSEY
GREAT BRITAIN

Member of the British BMX Freestyle Park team, Dylan Hessey quickly established himself on the international scene thanks to his fluid style and technical approach to BMX. A regular representative of his country at FISE competitions, he has won several stops on the tour. In 2025, he finished 3rd at the Montpellier stage before winning the European Championship in October.

BMX FREESTYLE PARK



UCI BMX FREESTYLE PARK WORLD CUP

PRESENTED BY NISSAN

BMX Freestyle is one of the flagship disciplines of urban sports, especially since its inclusion in the Olympic program in 2020. Its popularity is largely due to spectacular aerial tricks, made possible by the design of the Park, offering riders an ideal terrain to express their talent.

BMX FREESTYLE PARK PODIUM – FISE MONTPELLIER 2025 – WOMEN



SIBEI SUN
CHINA

A rising figure in BMX Freestyle Park, Sibe Sun established herself in 2023 as one of the most consistent riders on the world circuit, reaching multiple UCI World Cup finals. That same year, she won the silver medal at the World Championships in Glasgow, confirming her elite status. After narrowly missing the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, she continued to perform at the highest level with another world silver medal in 2024, before making history in 2025 by becoming the first non-American world champion in the discipline.



MIHARU OZAWA
JAPAN

A young Japanese prodigy, Miharu Ozawa emerged early on the international stage. At just 14 years old, she impressed by finishing 2nd in BMX Freestyle Park at FISE Montpellier 2024 thanks to an ambitious and spectacular run. In 2025, she delivered a breakthrough year by winning the overall UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup after her victory in Sakai and several podium finishes in Montpellier and Shanghai.



HANNAH ROBERTS
USA

A dominant figure in BMX Freestyle Park, Hannah Roberts quickly established herself as a global reference thanks to her technical skill and aerial style. World champion as early as 2017, she has won six world titles and six overall World Cup titles. An Olympic silver medalist at Tokyo 2020, she remains one of the major favorites on the international circuit, consistently delivering top-level performances at major competitions.



PARKOUR FREESTYLE PODIUM – FISE MONTPELLIER 2025 – MEN



LAUTARO CHIALVO BANTLE
ITALY

An athlete of Argentine origin representing Italy, Lautaro Chialvo Bantle is steadily establishing himself internationally thanks to his committed and creative freestyle style. He achieved the biggest result of his career in Montpellier in 2025 by winning gold, after already taking silver in a World Cup stage in Coimbra in 2024.



SHEA RUDOLPH
USA

A freestyle specialist known for his fluid, technical, and explosive style, combining creativity, precision, and dynamic sequences. Coming from gymnastics practiced with his twin brother, he turned to parkour in 2012 and quickly rose to the world elite. In 2025, he won silver at FISE Montpellier and bronze at the World Games in Chengdu.



ELOAN HITZ
FRANCE

At just 19, the French athlete is already impressing internationally. In 2024, he reached the World Championships final in Japan and confirmed his elite status. In 2025, he became World Games silver medalist in Chengdu and also won bronze at FISE Montpellier.

PARKOUR AREAS

These areas are equipped with blocks, walls, and bars to reproduce various obstacles found in urban environments. The FISE Montpellier Parkour areas give athletes the opportunity to use a wide range of physical techniques to overcome them.



PARKOUR WORLD CUP – FREESTYLE

An urban discipline, Parkour was partly popularized by cinema. It can be described as the art of moving from one point to another with maximum efficiency. In Freestyle, traceurs use obstacles to express their style and creativity while navigating structures built by Brick, the official infrastructure provider. The World Cup is organized in collaboration with World Gymnastics and the FFG

ELLA MARIA BUCIO
MEXICO

Ella Maria Bucio quickly became one of the favorites on the international freerunning scene thanks to her acrobatic movements and artistic style. In 2022, she became World Champion in Freestyle in Tokyo. That same year, she won gold at FISE Montpellier and another World Cup stage in Sofia. In 2024 she finished 2nd at FISE Montpellier before reclaiming the title in 2025.



NOA MAN
NETHERLANDS

Noa Man is one of the most talented Dutch parkour athletes of her generation. Known for her fluid, fast, and committed style, she quickly rose to the international scene. World champion at Red Bull Art of Motion 2021, she became the first World Games Freestyle champion in 2022, also winning silver in speed. She has since continued collecting international medals, including at FISE Montpellier.



ADELA MERKOVA
CZECH REPUBLIC

Former gymnast, Adéla Merkova has been developing in parkour since 2019. Along with her twin sister Vendula, she has achieved strong results in this emerging discipline. She won bronze at multiple World Cup events in 2021 and 2022, as well as at FISE Montpellier 2023 and 2025.



SHRED ZONE

Launched in 2024, the Shred Zone has become a FISE essential and will return in 2026 with an even more ambitious setup. Designed to host daily contests, it brings together riders from all disciplines throughout the event. Each day highlights a different discipline, offering participants the chance to win prize money or partner rewards.

BIKE LIFE ZONE

Bike Life is practiced on a flat surface ideal for trick lines. Like long American avenues, the Bike Life zone at FISE offers riders a dedicated space for expression. Safe and located at the heart of the festival, it highlights this emerging discipline.



BIKE LIFE CONTEST IN COLLABORATION WITH PATROX

Inspired by motocross ride-outs, **Bike Life** is now expanding from local scenes into city centers. On especially sturdy bikes with customized aesthetics, riders perform tricks held for as long as possible. Through ride-outs and trick lines, they reclaim urban space as a form of free expression.





MEDIA GUIDE

GEORGES FRÊCHE SQUARE – OPEN TO ALL

Access to Georges Frêche Square, including the iconic Spine Ramp, remains free and open to the public every day until 11:30 PM to watch competitions and night shows.

3X3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT (FFBB X HÉRAULT BASKETBALL COMMITTEE)

Born on the streets, 3x3 basketball is now part of the Olympic urban sports program since 2020. At the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, the French men's team won silver.

After joining the FISE Montpellier program in 2024, the 3x3 tournament returns this year to Georges Frêche Square. In Montpellier, 8 Pro Men's teams and 8 Pro Women's teams will compete, along with U18 categories for boys and girls.



MEDIA GUIDE

THE SPINE RAMP : FISE ICONIC NIGHT SESSIONS

The Spine Ramp consists of two ramps meeting at a central ridge forming a W shape. This allows athletes to perform aerial tricks while giving spectators an optimal viewing angle.

SPINE RAMP CONTEST: BMX, SCOOTERING, SKATEBOARDING & ROLLERBLADING

The Spine Ramp is a FISE Montpellier icon where, regardless of discipline, the focus is on the show. Riders use both sides of the ramp and the central spine to create runs that electrify the crowd. While tricks differ across BMX, scooter, roller, and skate, the structure is perfectly suited to all disciplines.

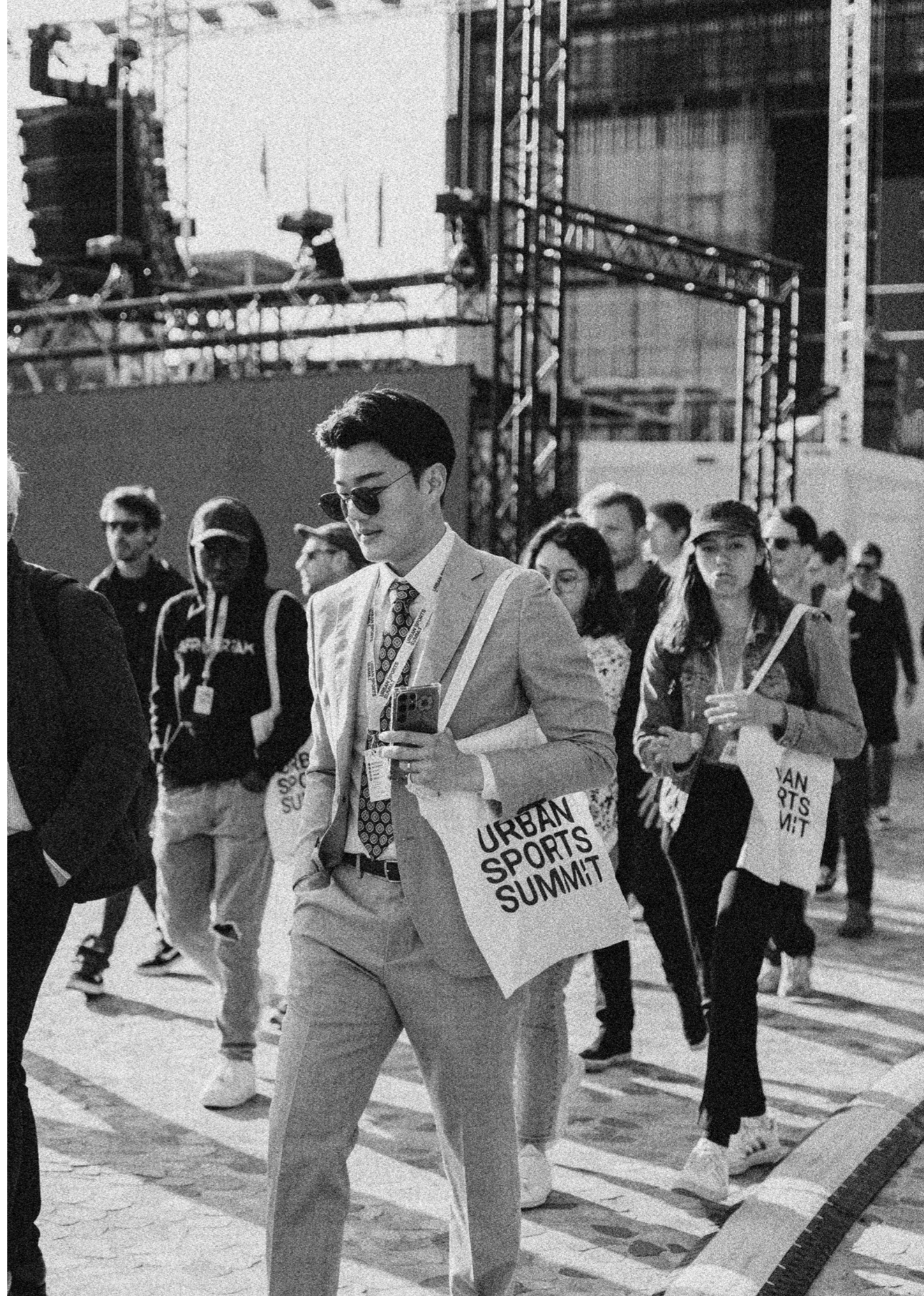

ENJOY FISE



For nearly 30 years, FISE Montpellier has been built on a unique closeness with its audience. Much more than a sporting event, it is a true community that gathers every year: riders, organizers, DJs, speakers, judges, participants, and partners come together to share a vibrant experience. While competitions remain the highlights of the festival, a wide range of activities enrich the adventure, making FISE an event to be lived as much as it is watched.

HIGH-FLYING TRICKS & FORMULA E WITH NISSAN

Nissan strengthens its presence in 2026 as Major Partner and Naming Partner of BMX Freestyle Park. The brand is deploying an immersive setup around the e-LAB Formula E module, offering racing simulators, scale models, and interactive activities to immerse the public in the world of motorsport and competition. Located at the heart of the festival, near the VIP area, the Nissan stand is a central attraction point.

On the exhibition side, the hybrid Juke, the Juke Skio, and the new 100% electric MICRA will be showcased, while the VIP area will also feature electrified models from the range. Nissan will also provide festival logistics with a dedicated fleet (Primastar, ARIYA, and X-Trail) for athlete and team transportation. Finally, influencers Ma_Tribu and UnseenSamy will share their immersion in Nissan activations and the FISE experience.

HARLEY-DAVIDSON

For the first time, Harley-Davidson joins FISE Montpellier as a supporting partner, with an immersive setup at the heart of the festival. In its dedicated space, the brand will offer a full motorcycle experience: a riding simulator allowing the public to feel the sensations of riding, an exhibition of iconic models, and DJ entertainment on the stand, located near the FISE Stage.

INSTAX

Instax will host exclusive autograph sessions with Anthony Jeanjean and Laury Perez, iconic figures of FISE Montpellier and French BMX. Set in a friendly space, the activation will allow visitors to meet the guests, interact with them, and leave with instant memories captured through the Instax universe.



FISE APPAREL

The official FISE brand will be highlighted through daily animations at its stand, including kendama demonstrations, a playful and technical discipline rapidly growing in urban culture. In addition, autograph sessions will be organized with Alex Jumelin & Bastos, allowing the public to meet these key figures of the FISE community.



SODEBO

Sodebo will offer a dynamic and participatory activation space, designed as a true playground for FISE visitors. Several experiences will be featured throughout the event: a human bowling game for fun collective challenges, speed tests to measure reflexes and agility, and a giant reimaged Twister. Product tastings will complement the activation, allowing the public to discover Sodebo ranges in a friendly and festive atmosphere.

The FISE Cam returns to showcase the best of the crowd! Located at the BMX Freestyle Park, it will capture your reactions, smiles, and most intense vibes during short daily sessions of about ten minutes on Saturday and Sunday. Be ready!

XXL FOOD COURT & DJ SETS

This year, the Food Court area expands and becomes a true living space within the festival. At its center, Charal deploys a food truck and a stand equipped with a giant screen broadcasting exclusive FISE x Charal content, competition replays, and live coverage on Saturday and Sunday.

On the food side, an original activation will animate the days: each day, a Charal product will be highlighted and reinvented by Théo Ligani, a food

influencer leading this creative culinary experience. He will welcome a different urban sports personality daily to share a preparation and tasting moment featuring original recipes, blending conviviality, performance, and creativity.

Finally, to extend the festival atmosphere, the Food Court area will remain open until 11 PM and host DJ sets, making it a central gathering place throughout the day and evening.



FAMILY PARK

Designed for families and younger audiences, the Family Park is a space fully dedicated to sports discovery and creativity. Throughout the week, children can try urban sports through free sessions supervised by professionals, with equipment and safety gear provided.

Among the highlights: the FISE Kids Rider Cup, open to children aged 2 to 5, allows them to ride a specially designed balance bike track. Prizes include meet-and-greets, memories... and goodies to take home!



ART & CREATIVITY WITH POSCA

Because urban culture goes beyond sport, FISE Montpellier also offers accessible artistic workshops. An art collective will host customization sessions with Posca in the Chill Zone, where children and parents can personalize caps, skateboards, or any other object.

In parallel, a collaborative mural will be created live in the Chill Zone. Designed as an evolving artwork throughout the festival, it will invite visitors to contribute, turning the space into a true hub of collective artistic expression and co-creation.



FREE INTRODUCTORY SESSIONS



Whether you are a beginner or simply curious, FISE is the perfect place to discover urban sports. Across different areas of the festival, free guided initiation sessions allow participants to try BMX, roller, skateboarding, scooter, and other disciplines. For several years, FISE has been developing an ambitious responsible approach aimed at reducing its environmental impact, promoting equity and inclusion, and ensuring a safe framework for all audiences. Through the expertise of Hurricane Group and its various subsidiaries, each event is designed within a framework of continuous improvement, integrating sustainable development challenges from the very beginning.

Hurricane Group's CSR policy is based on a rigorous evaluation of actions already implemented, the definition of short-, medium-, and long-term objectives, and the formalization of shared values communicated to employees, service providers, and partners. This approach includes an analysis of supplier practices, mapping of logistics flows, carbon footprint assessments, and the implementation of internal awareness tools. The group also supports its partners in adopting best practices while developing responsible activations at events.

AN ISO 20121-CERTIFIED EVENT

In 2024, FISE obtained ISO 20121 certification, an international standard dedicated to sustainable event management. It recognizes the festival's commitment to reducing its environmental, social, and economic impacts. FISE has also recently obtained the "Terrain d'égalité" label (2026-2029) and now complies with the Charter of 12 commitments of the Metropolis, confirming the structure and continuity of its responsible policy.

WASTE MANAGEMENT AND REUSE

Selective sorting is deployed across the entire site to encourage waste reduction and recovery. Dedicated areas are set up for recyclable and compostable materials, while teams ensure proper compliance with guidelines.

Particular attention is given to material reuse, especially in the design of temporary infrastructures, and partners are encouraged to adopt similar practices.

REDUCING THE CARBON FOOTPRINT

Concrete actions are implemented to limit CO₂ emissions: encouragement of soft mobility and public transport, use of low-impact materials for event structures, and more.

Reducing plastic use and waste is also a key priority, in close collaboration with the Montpellier Metropolis. Water fountains, reuse systems, and reinforced sorting all contribute to this goal.

SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY AND PARTNERSHIP WITH liO

As part of its carbon footprint reduction policy, FISE relies on a partnership with liO, the public transport network of the Occitanie Region, operated by SNCF Voyageurs.

This partnership aims to make it easier to reach the event using public transport, particularly for younger audiences. FISE thus promotes the initiatives offered by liO, including the +0 offer, accessible via the Fairtiq app, which allows 12-26 year-olds to benefit from advantageous pricing conditions on the liO Train and Coach network in Occitanie.

EQUITY, INCLUSION AND SAFETY: CORE VALUES OF FISE

GENDER EQUALITY IN SPORT

FISE works toward fair representation in its competitions and within its teams. Female athletes benefit from the same participation opportunities, equal prize money, and increased visibility in communication systems.

PREVENTION OF SEXIST AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE (SSV)

As part of its CSR commitments and certifications, FISE deploys a strict prevention strategy.

Mandatory training is provided to all staff (organizers, volunteers, security teams) to raise awareness of different forms of violence and appropriate responses.

Sensitive areas are identified across the site to strengthen security presence, while a clear, confidential, and effective reporting protocol is in place, along with immediate intervention measures when necessary.

ACCESSIBILITY AND INCLUSION FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Each edition of FISE is designed to welcome people with disabilities in the best possible conditions. The site is adapted to facilitate movement and provide dedicated access (PRM), specific equipment, and personalized support.

Some competitions and activities are also open to athletes with disabilities, helping make the festival a truly inclusive space.

▶ HURRICANE GROUP



Hurricane is an international group specialized in urban sports, covering the entire value chain: from event creation to content production, as well as the design and development of infrastructure around the world.

A leading player in the sector, the group is the founder of FISE Montpellier and the developer of the UCI BMX Freestyle World Cup stages. Through its projects, Hurricane actively contributes to the structuring, professionalization, and international growth of urban sports disciplines.

By working alongside brands, cities, and institutions, the group develops systems and experiences designed to engage new generations. Its approach is based on creativity, innovation, and a strong understanding of user behavior, with a clear ambition: to make urban sports a cultural, social, and territorial driver on a global scale.



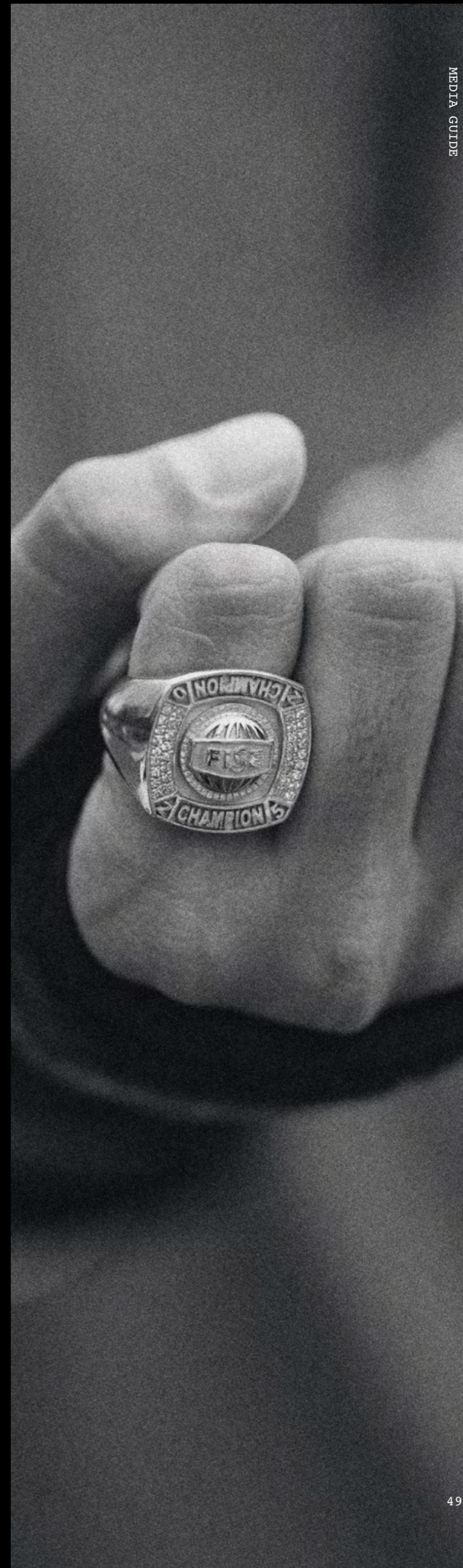
▶ The FISE ecosystem

In partnership with international and national sports federations, Hurricane and FISE are proud to have contributed to the creation and development of new sporting events focused on young audiences, now integrated into the Olympic program.

Today recognized as a key French gathering for both amateur and professional riders, the Montpellier stage has evolved into a unique platform within the sporting event calendar. Riders, federations, advertisers, broadcasters, influencers... all come together to experience FISE and explore new development opportunities.

One of the major outcomes of these exchanges is the success of the partnership between Hurricane and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI), initiated in 2016. By including UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cups, and more recently BMX Flatland on the festival's world tour stages, both organizations combine their expertise to further grow these disciplines. In 2017, this dynamic attracted the attention of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as an observer, before the announcement just two weeks later of BMX Freestyle Park's inclusion in the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.

Beyond elite sporting competitions, Hurricane Group is also responsible for the design, production, and installation of the structures on which they take place. This "by riders, for riders" expertise also explains its role as a provider of training parks for the UCI (Switzerland) and the French National BMX Freestyle Center (Montpellier), helping athletes prepare for the Olympic Games.



↘ HURRICANE PARKS

- benchmark sports facilities

Since the earliest FISE events, internalizing the production of sports areas has always been essential. The Hurricane Parks division designs, manufactures, and assembles the structures. Team members, all of whom practice at least one urban sports discipline, bring their expertise to ensure the highest quality facilities—essential to attracting new riders to the festival.

This recognition has also led to partnerships with major international federations such as World Skate (WS), the International Gymnastics Federation (FIG), and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). The UCI has also entrusted them with structures for its top-level competitions (World Cups, Championships, and Olympic Games).

↘ FISE BUSINESS SCHOOL

- a school at the heart of urban sports

The FISE Business School offers training in marketing, management, and sports event management, both full-time and in work-study programs, to best integrate students into the national and international sports ecosystem. United by the same passion, students are selected for their interest in action sports and for the complementarity of their profiles, representing all stakeholders involved in their development.

Opened in 2021, the first campus in Montpellier has welcomed more than a hundred passionate students. A second campus in Thonon-les-Bains, a hub for outdoor sports, opened in 2024.

↘ BRICK

- flexible and adaptable parkour training areas

BRICK was created with the aim of inspiring and sharing the values of Parkour with as many people as possible by designing a range of modular, lightweight, and durable equipment dedicated to Parkour. Today, BRICK allows traceurs to design, modify, and safely use their own training or competition areas.

↘ PRINT EVENT

- visibility experts for events

Since 1997, Hurricane Group has combined professional expertise with deep knowledge of event production by offering increasingly effective strategies. The integration of D-Day Vision into the group in 2019, leading to the creation of Print Event, now gives the group full technical and graphic capabilities from this former subcontractor, enabling it to manage all its printing needs. A key asset that allows the group to deliver complete event communication and signage solutions.

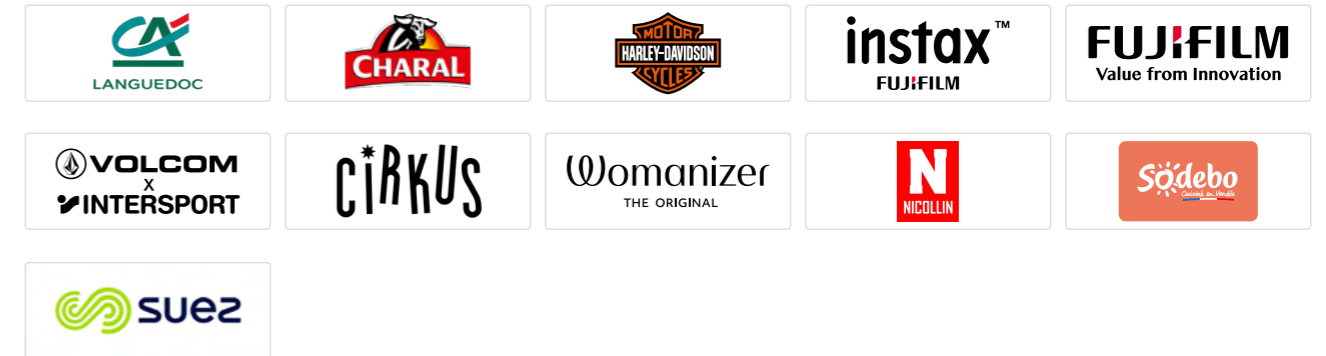
